Presentation of results

Where percentages are used, they are rounded to the nearest whole number. The “base” is the sample base from which the percentages are calculated. In all questions, the sample base is all respondents to that particular question. Any variation from this is noted and explained in the main body of the report. Note that if respondents could select more than one answer to a particular question, the percentages may add up to more than 100%. In some instances quite high numbers of respondents did not answer a particular question and this should be taken into account when interpreting the results. For those questions that included a free text box for ‘other’ options please note that as this option was not always listed as a tick box option in such cases those that selected ‘other’ are not included in the responses to the main question. The ‘other’ responses appear in the separate lists of free text comments.

Answers to questions requiring a free text answer are not included in this report, only the number of respondents. The comments provided can be found in a separate document ‘Madley Community Led Planning Questionnaire - full list of comments’.

Respondents over 18 were invited to complete one questionnaire on behalf of the household, with a separate questionnaire for respondents aged under 18. Please note that because the numbers of responses to the young persons’ questionnaire was quite small, extra care should be taken when interpreting these results.

Results

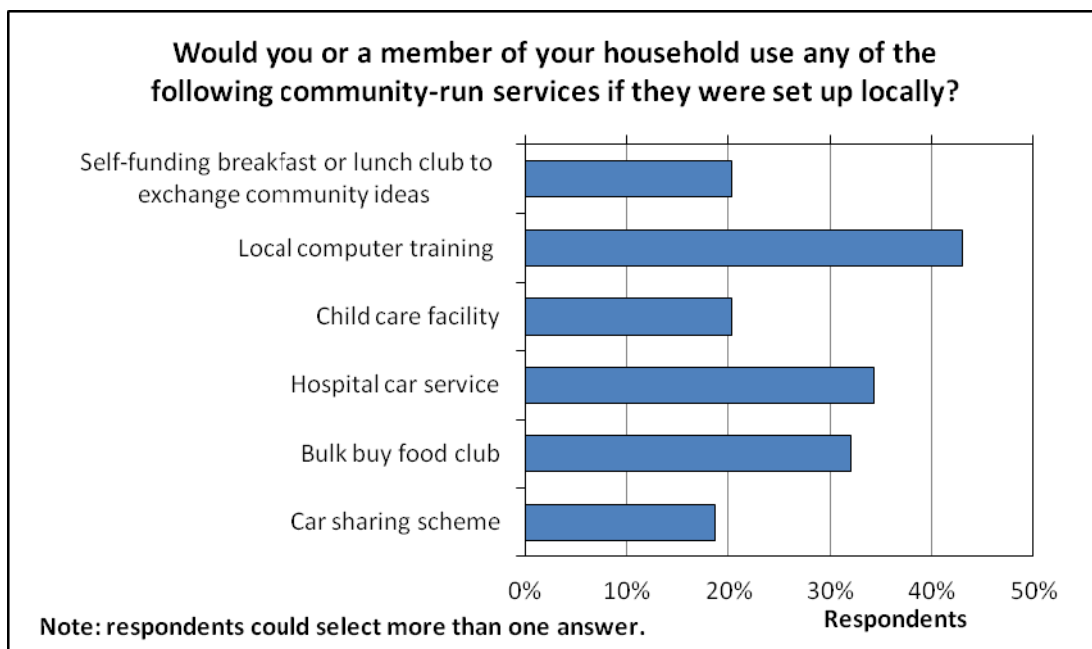
There were 475 questionnaires distributed in the parish. One person aged 18 or over in the household was invited to complete the survey on behalf of the household. A total of 247 completed questionnaires were received giving a 52% response rate. There were also 95 young people's questionnaires distributed. This questionnaire was aimed at young people under 18 years old in each household. A total of 55 responses were received to the young people's questionnaire giving a response rate of 58%.

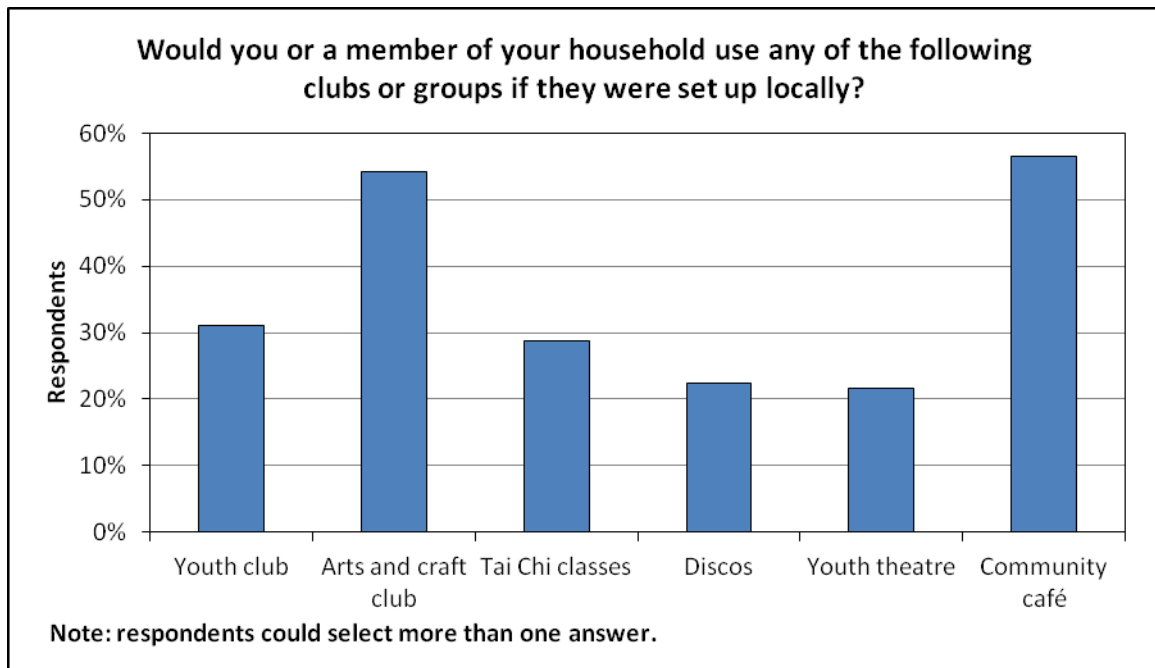

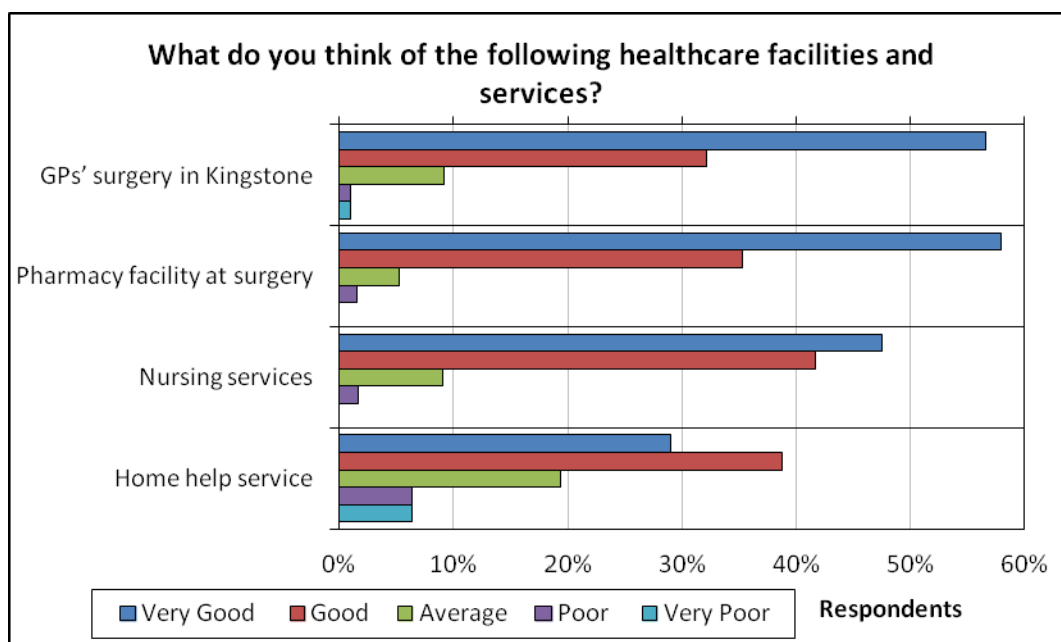

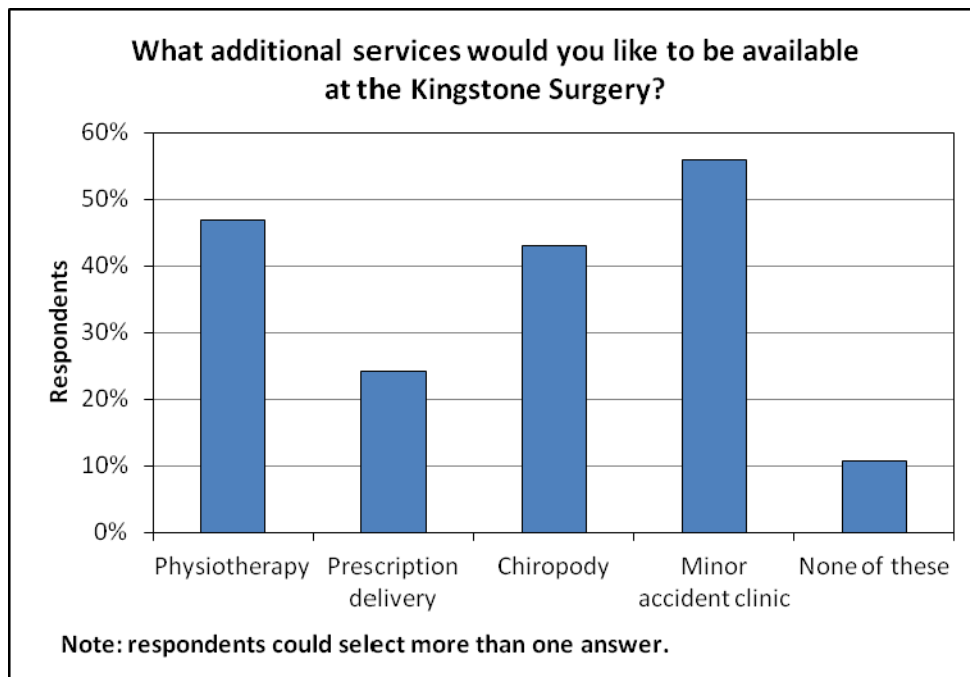

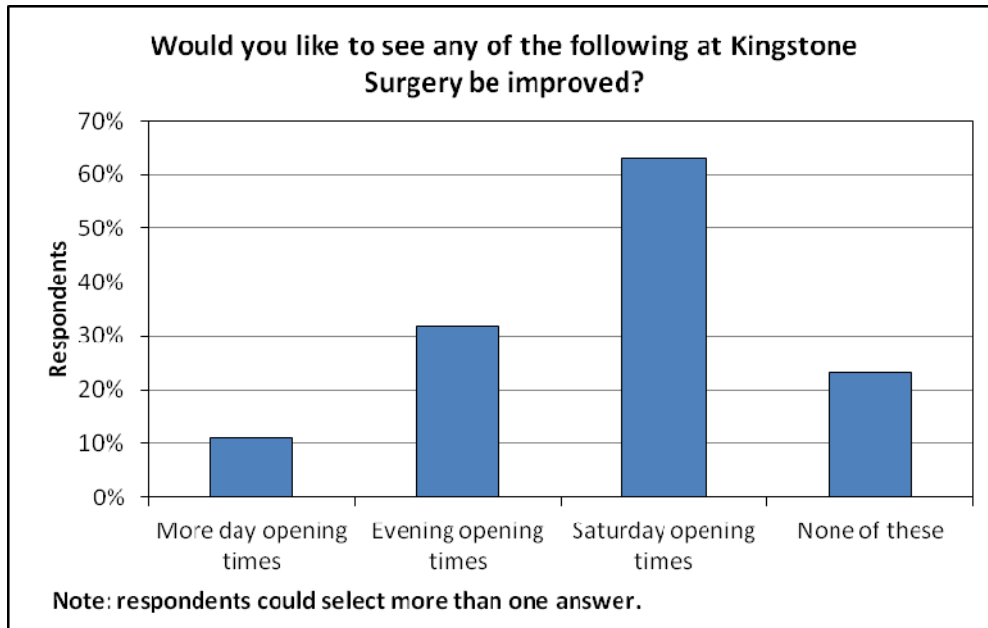

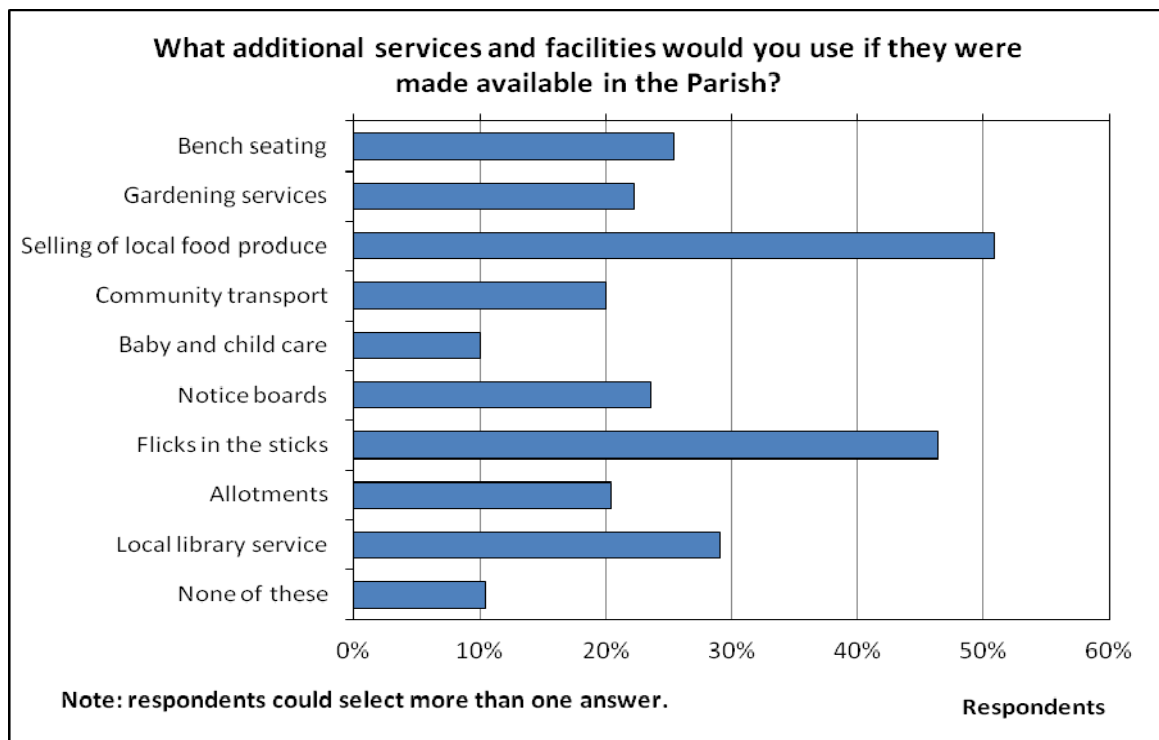

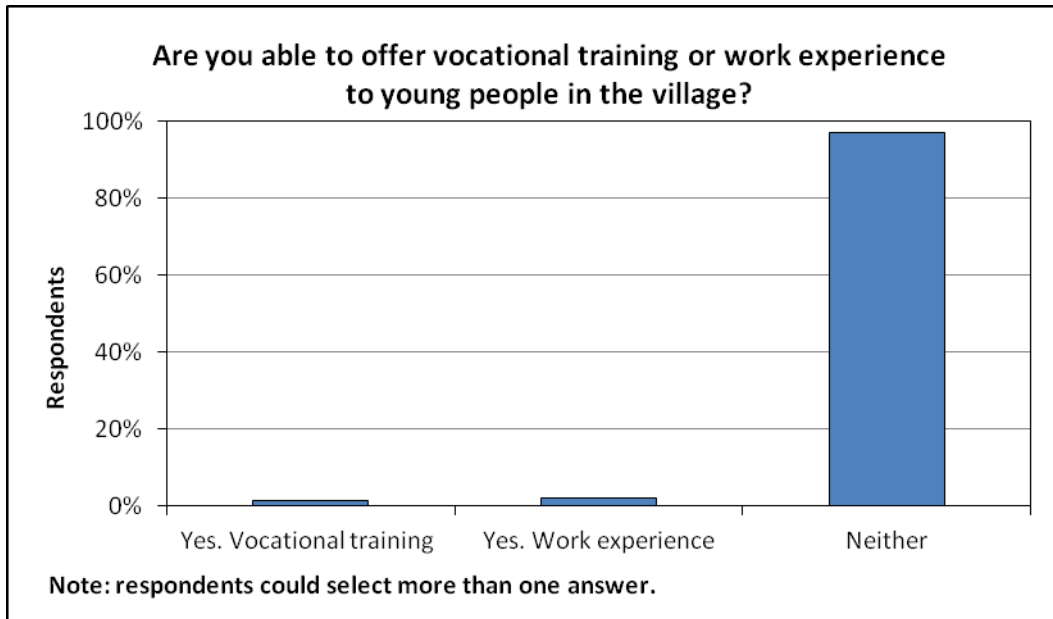

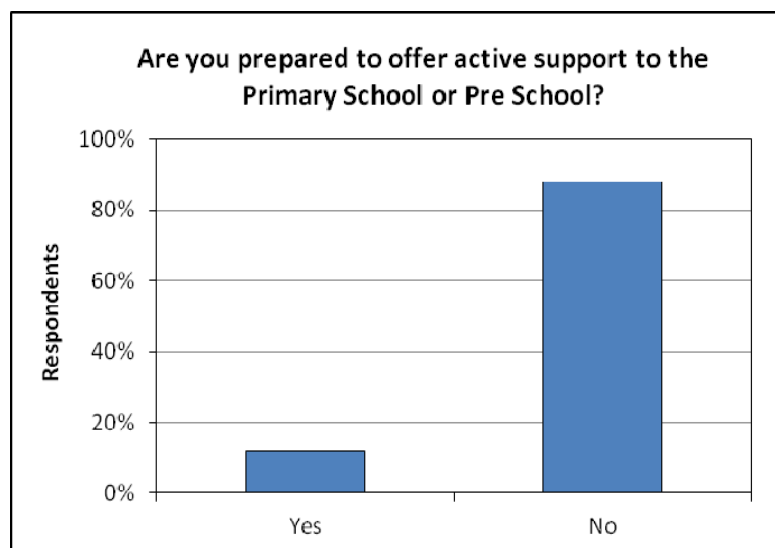

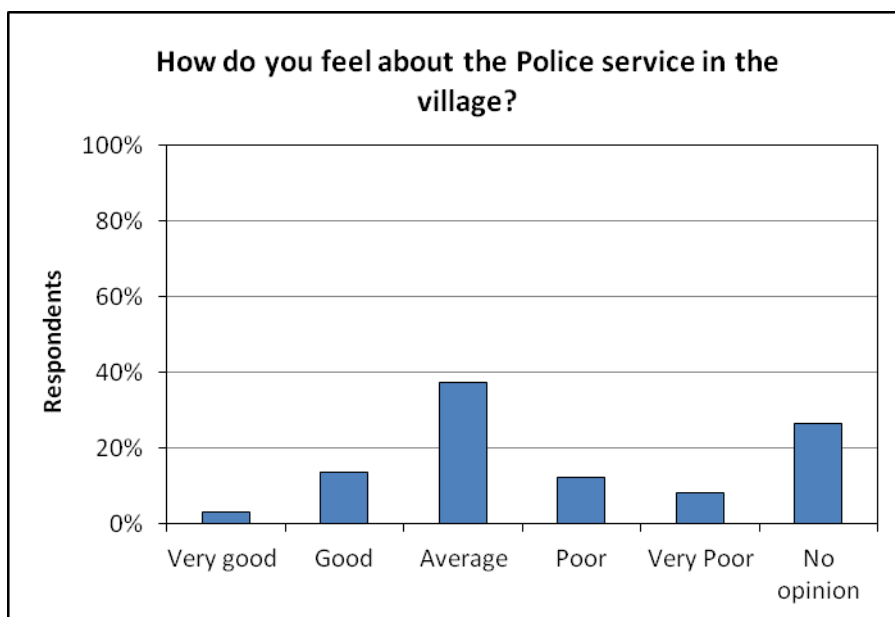

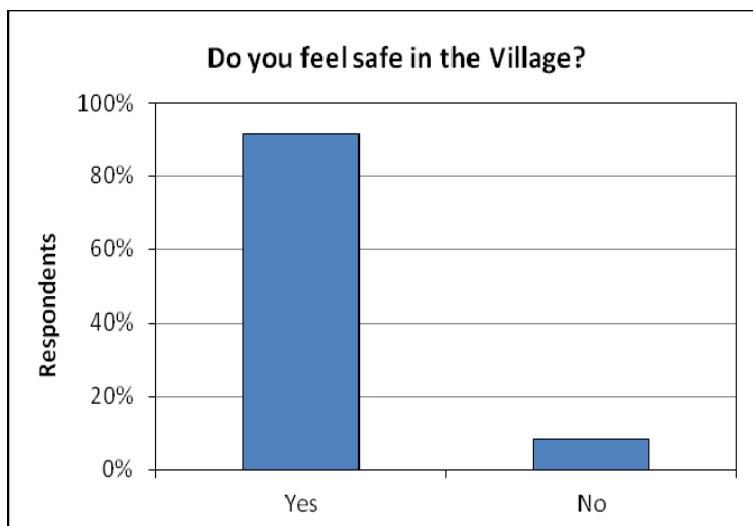

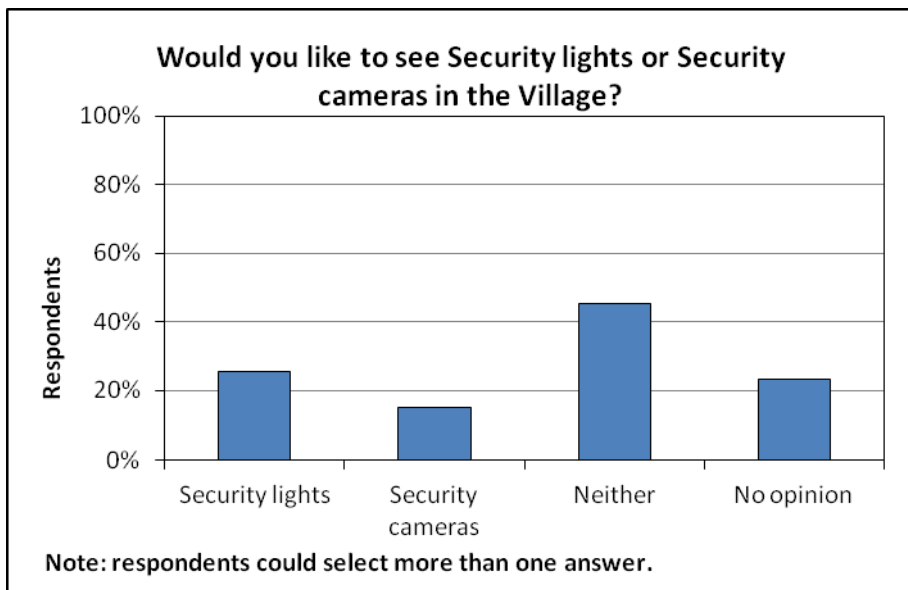

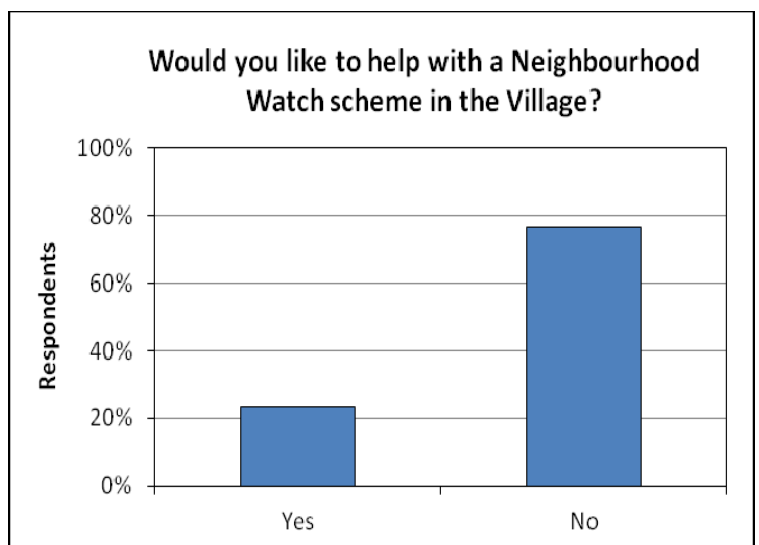

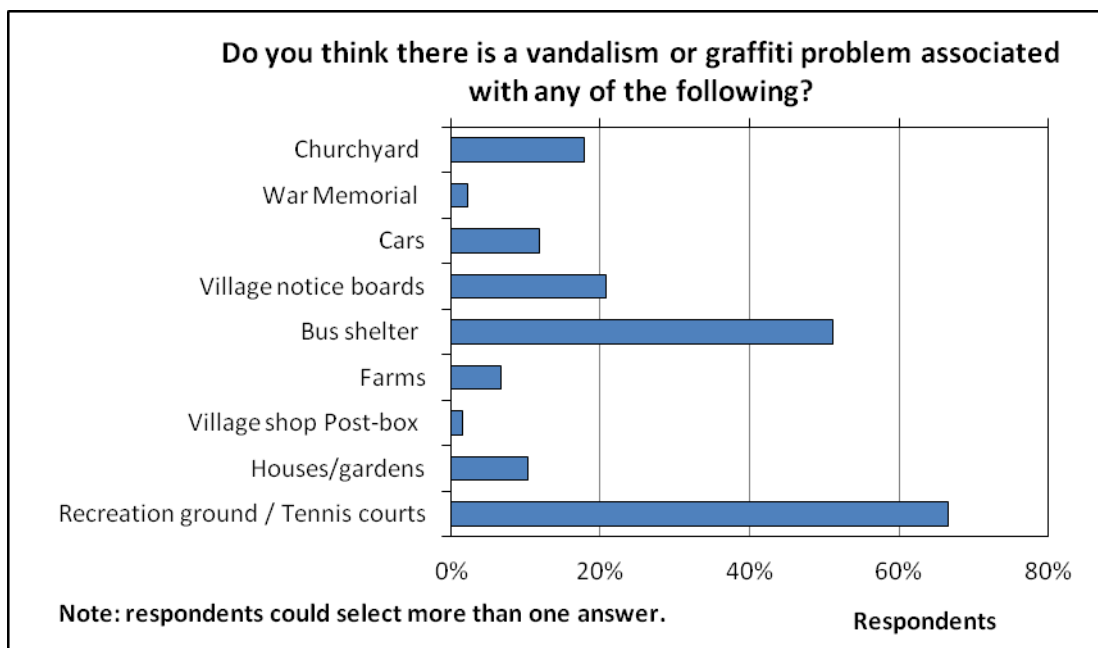
Q14. Would you like to be involved in a residents association?

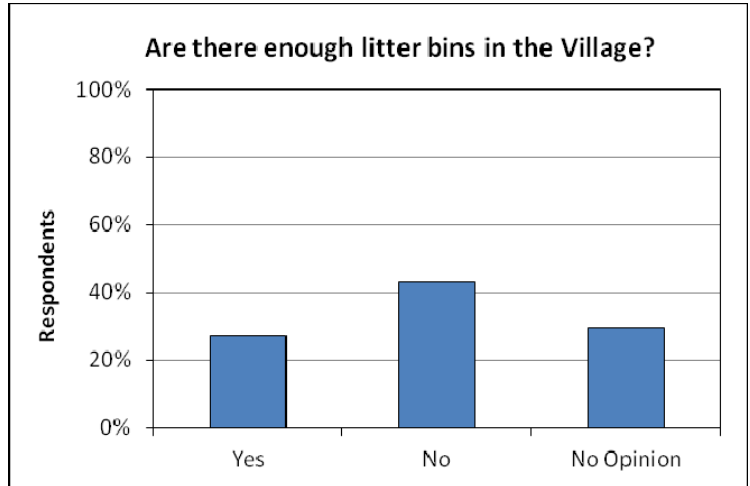

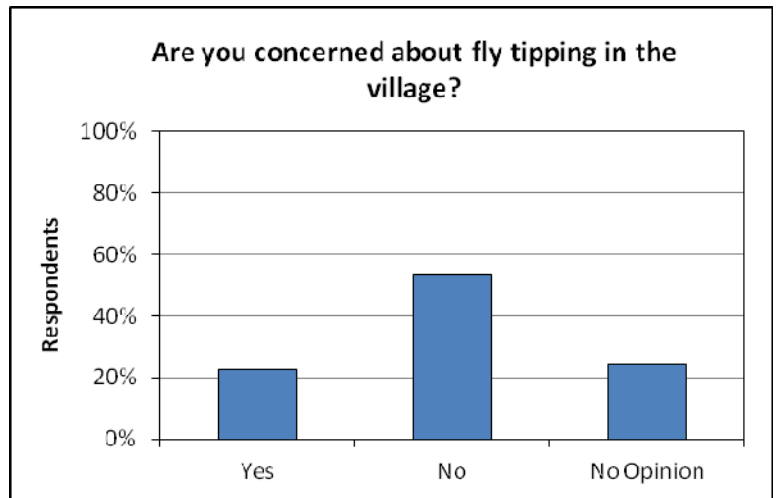

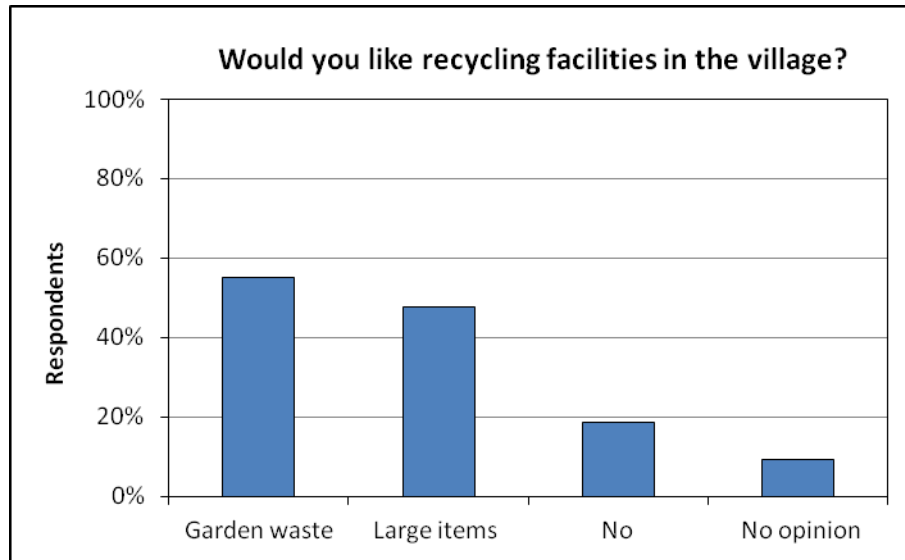

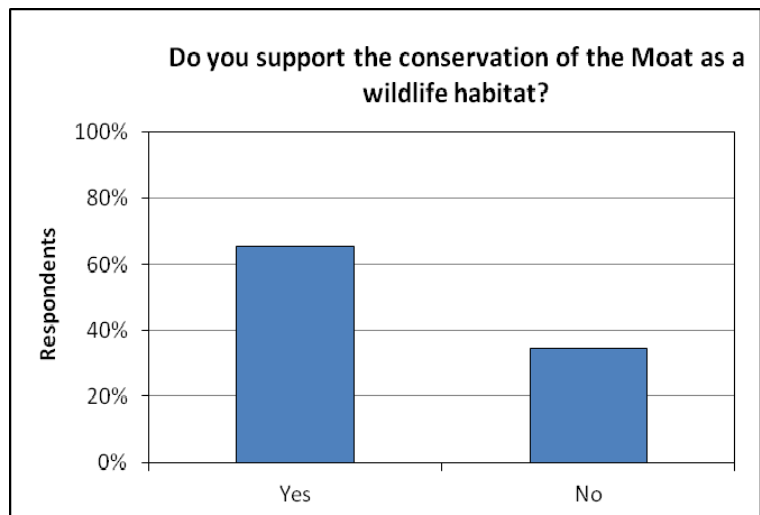
Q22. Do you visit Madley Moat?

Q23. Do you support the conservation of the Moat as a wildlife habitat?

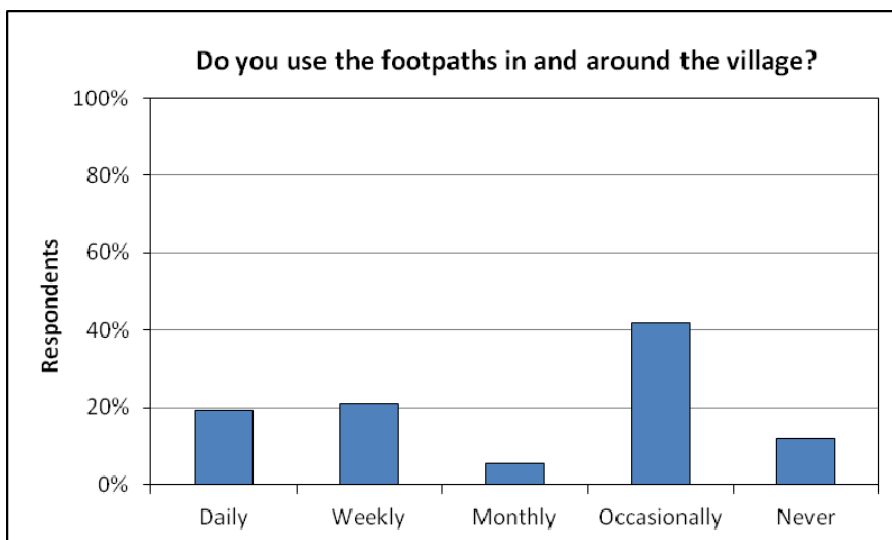

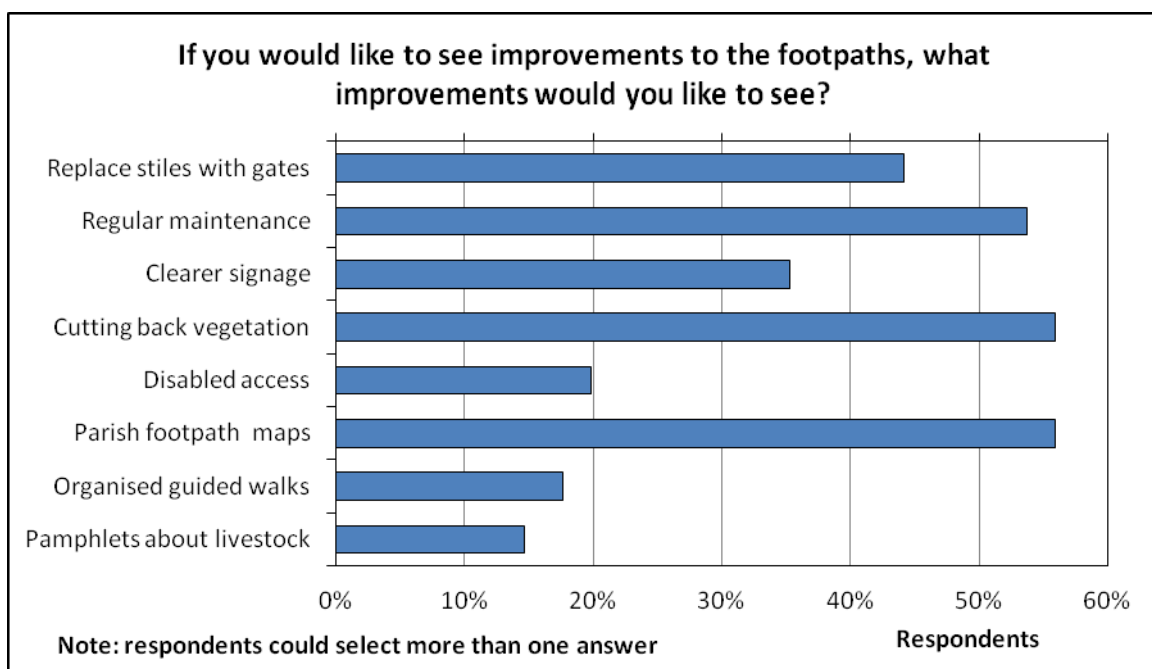

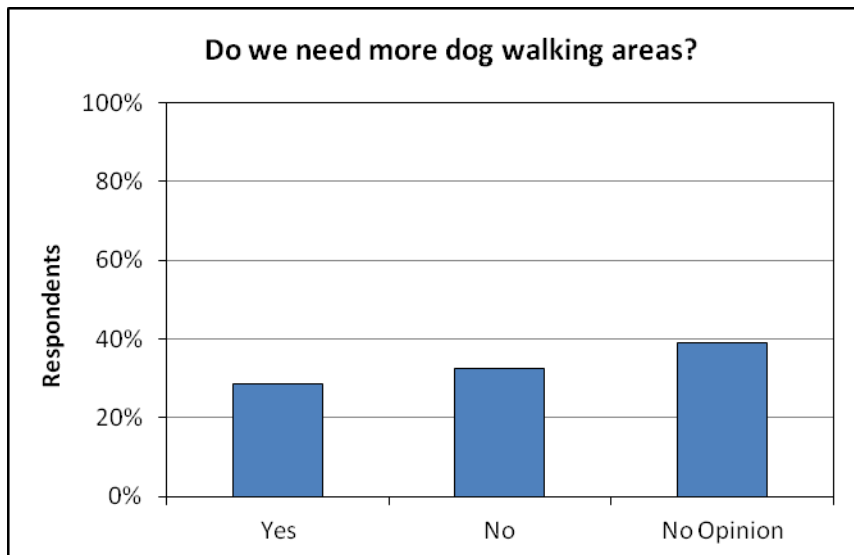

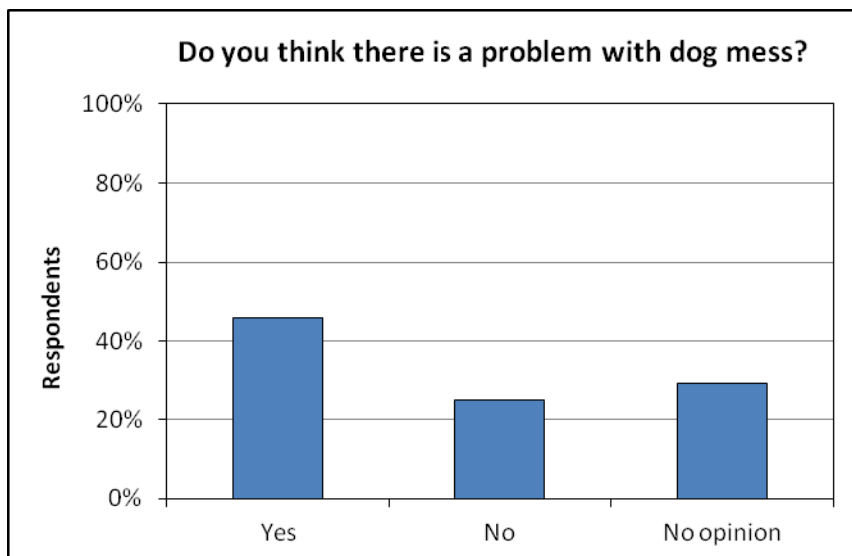
Q27. Do we need more dog walking areas?

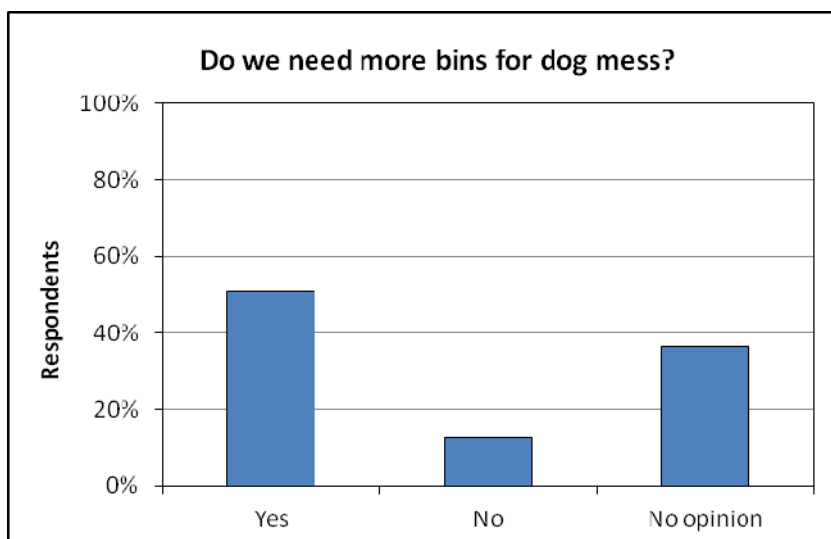

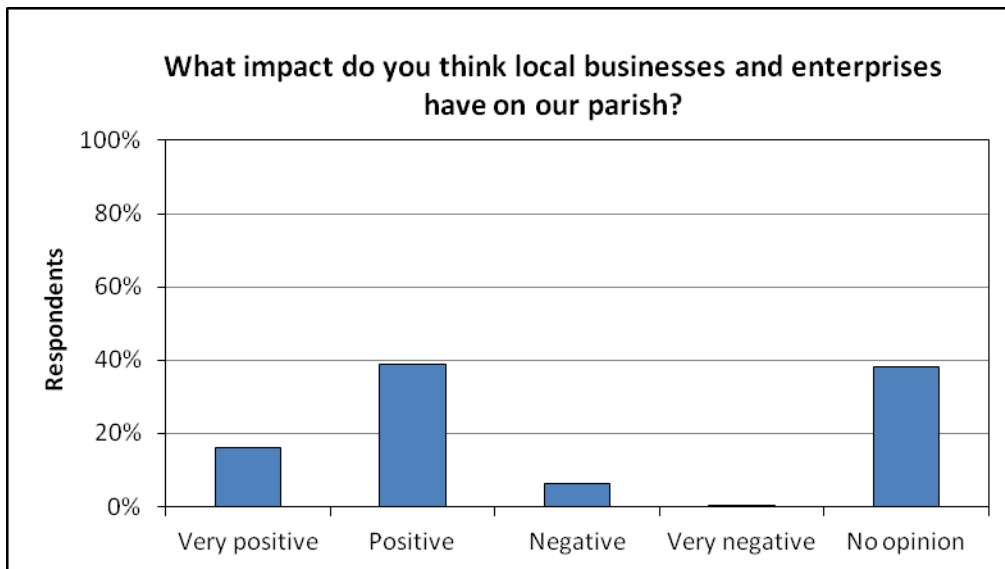

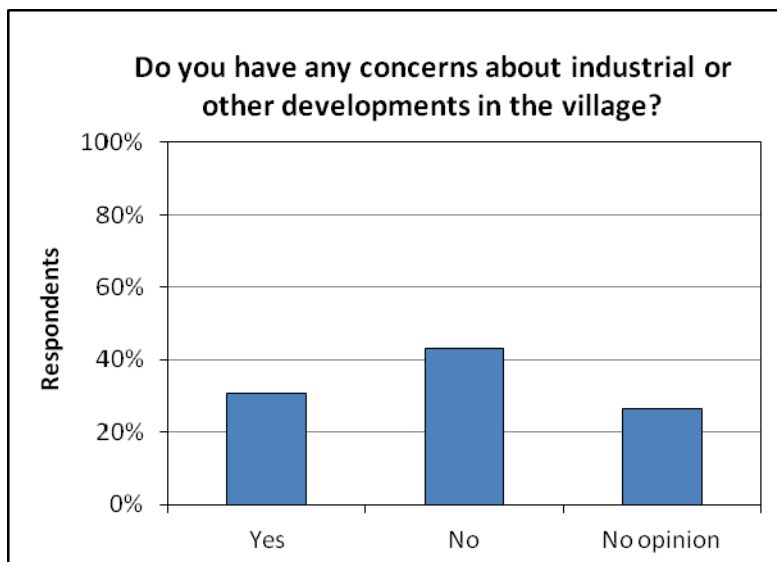

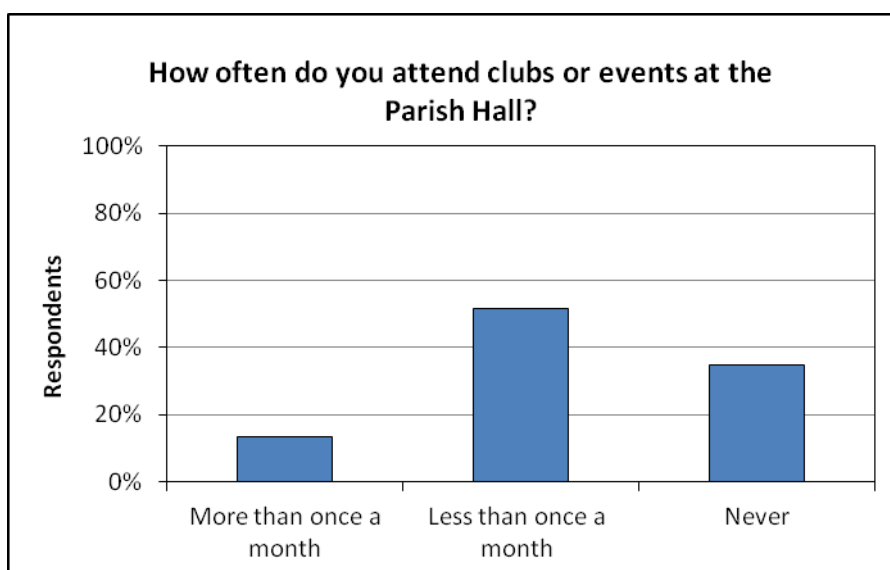

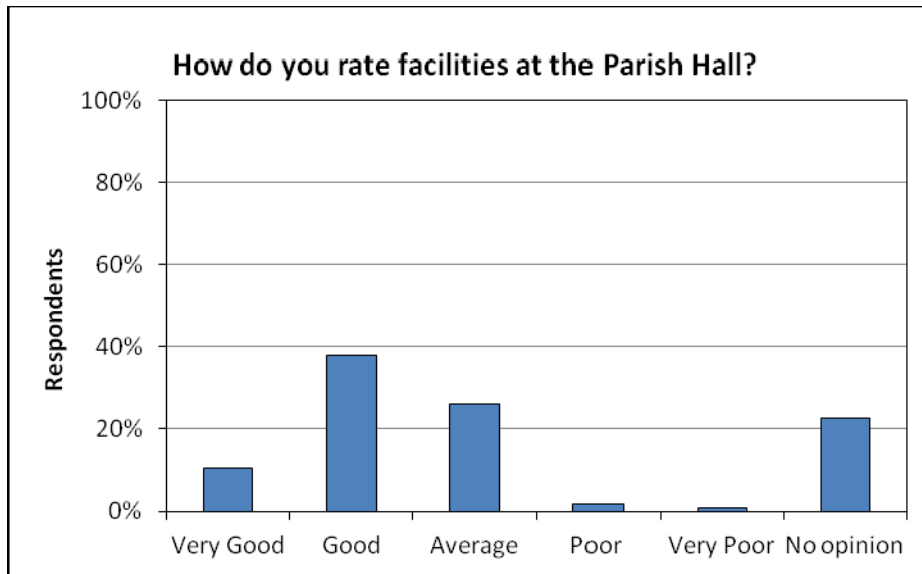

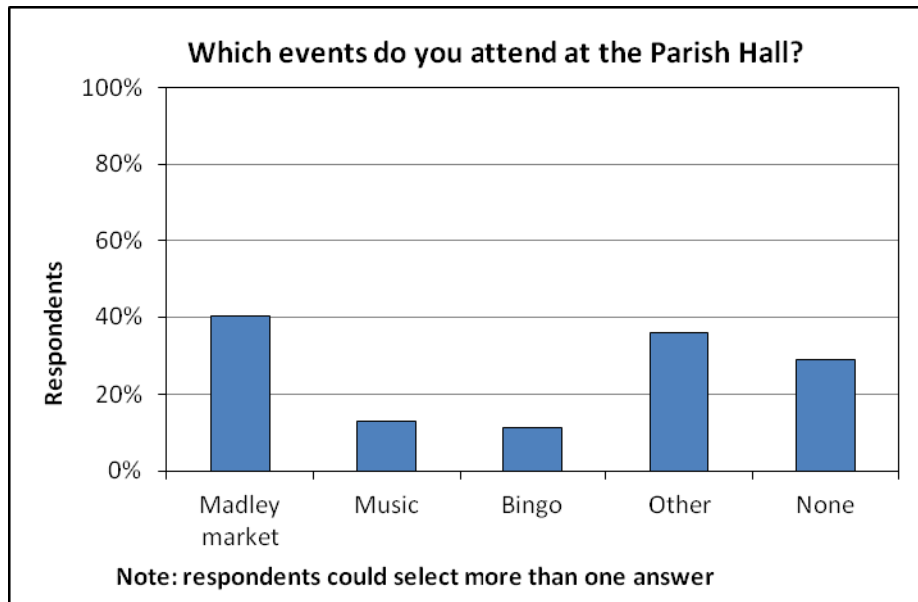
How could the Hall be improved?

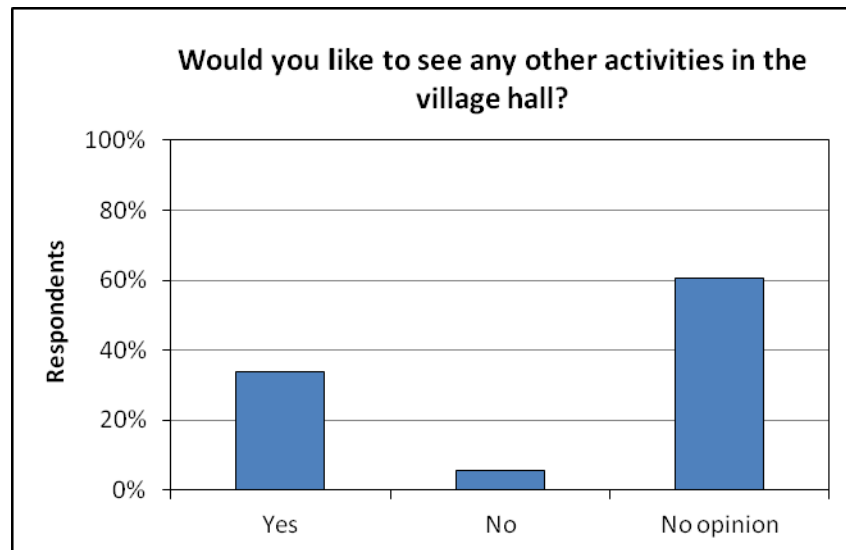

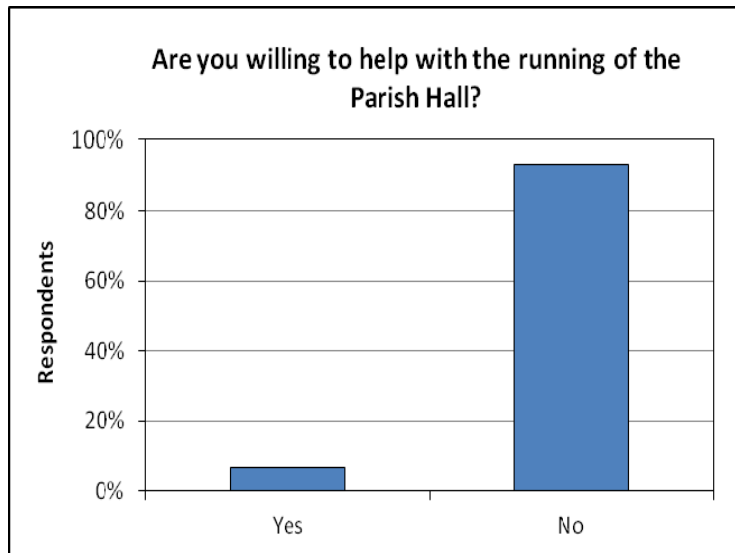

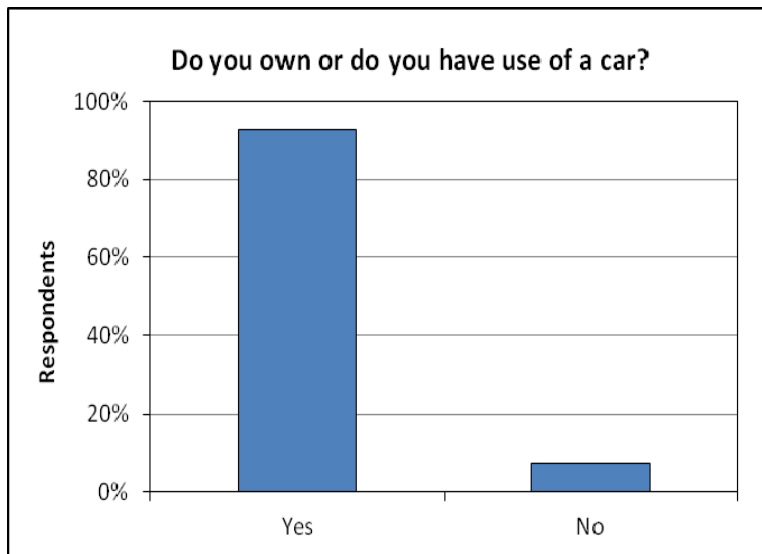

Q38. How often do you use the local bus service?

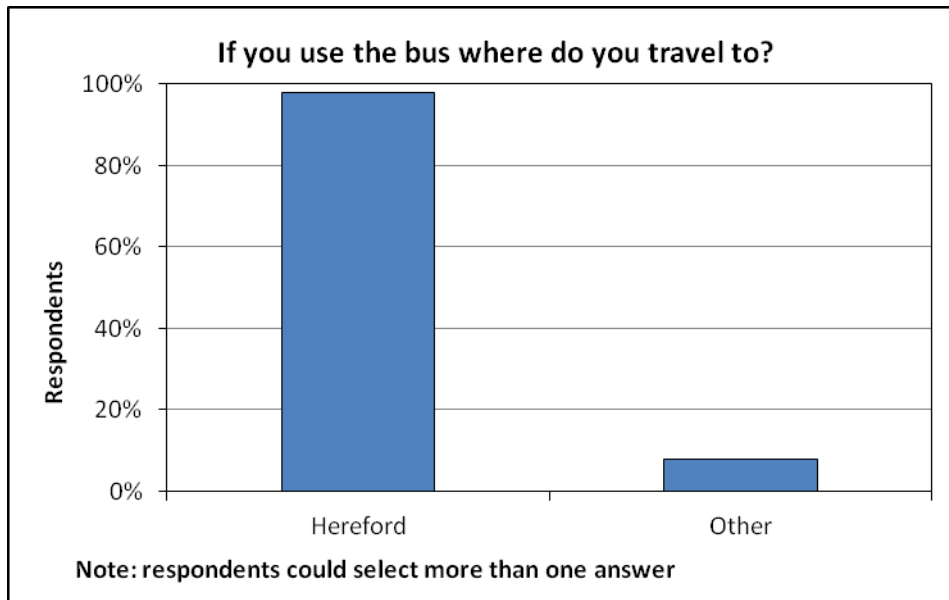

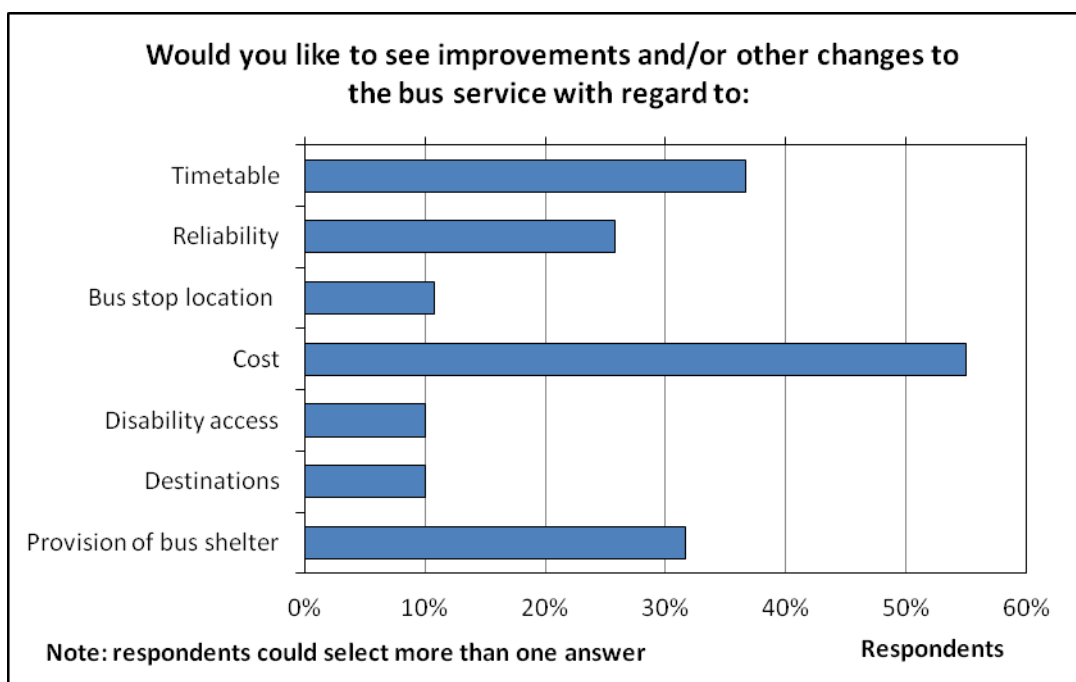

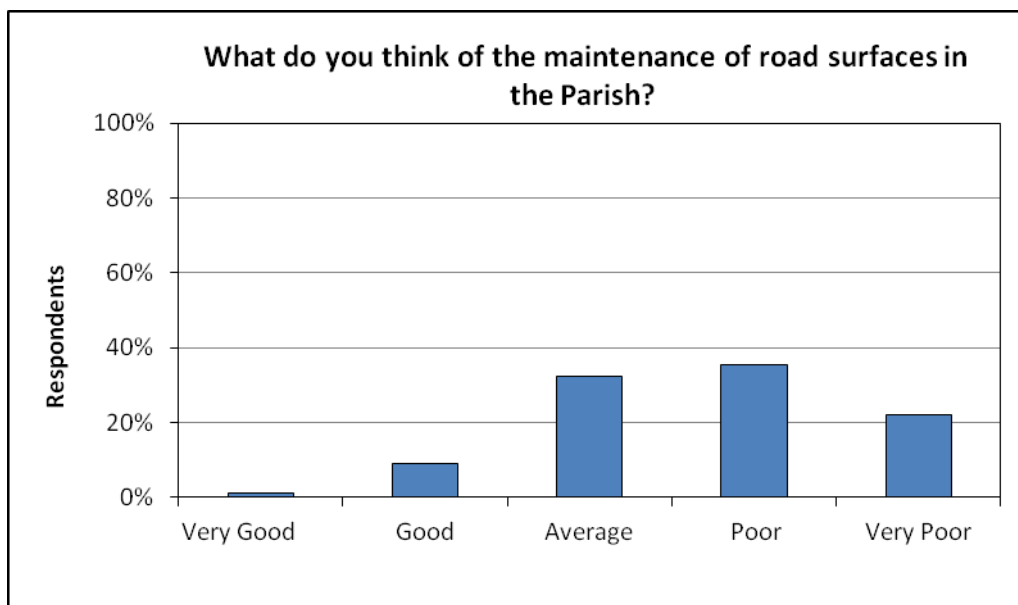
Q43. As the cost of motoring increases, are you likely to use the bus service more? (This would probably have to be financed locally)

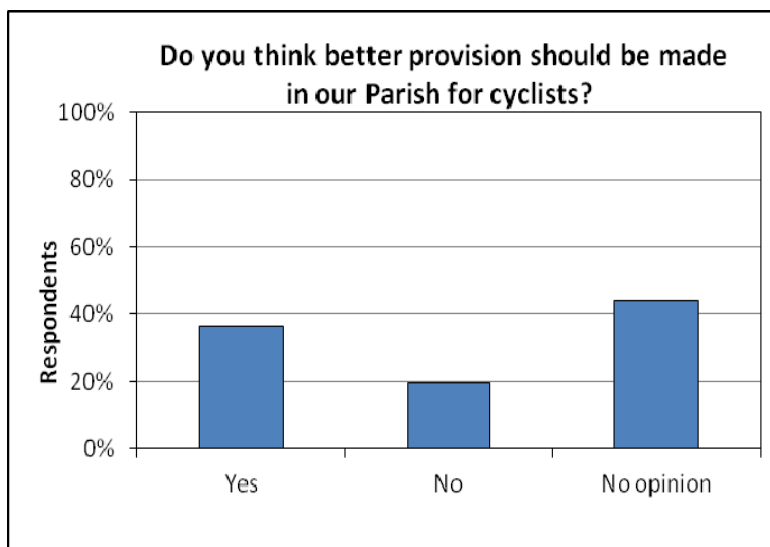
Q44. What do you think of the maintenance of road surfaces in the Parish?

Q45. Do you think better provision should be made in our Parish for cyclists?

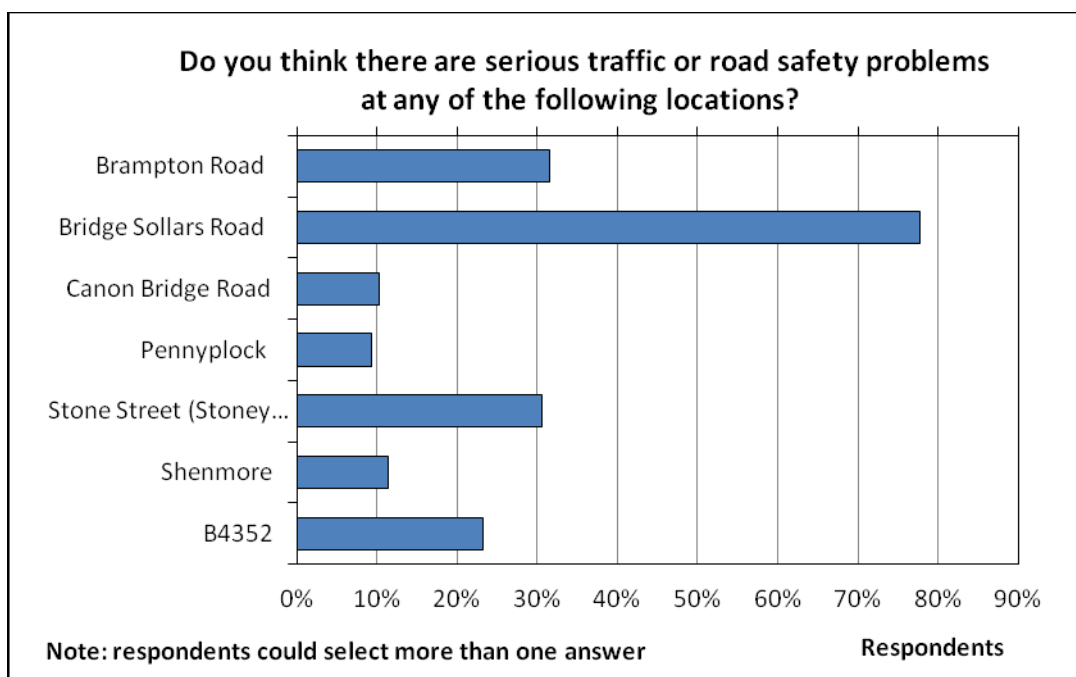

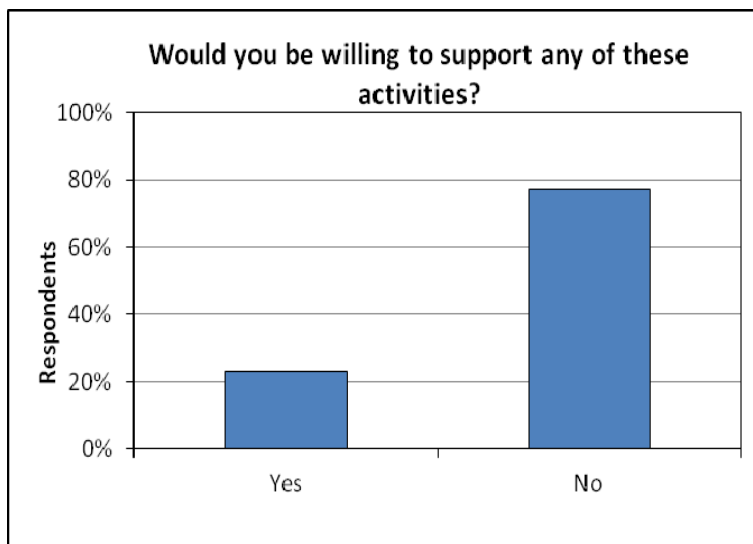

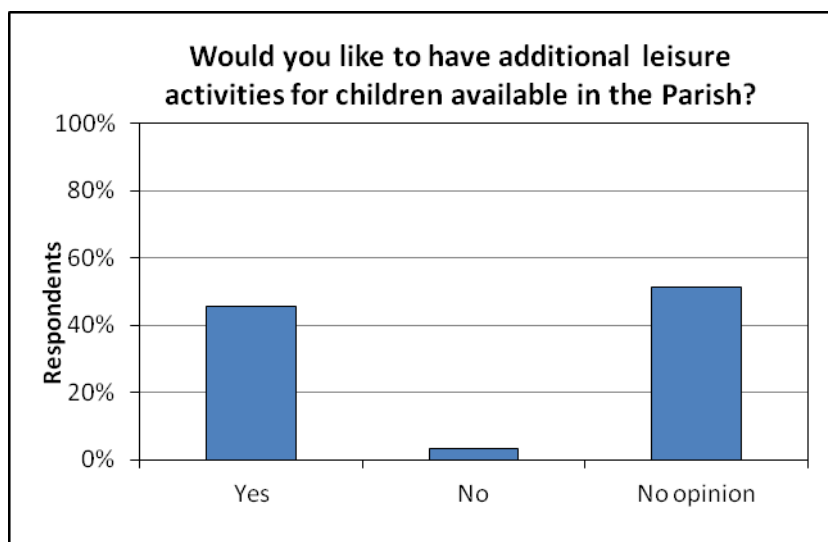

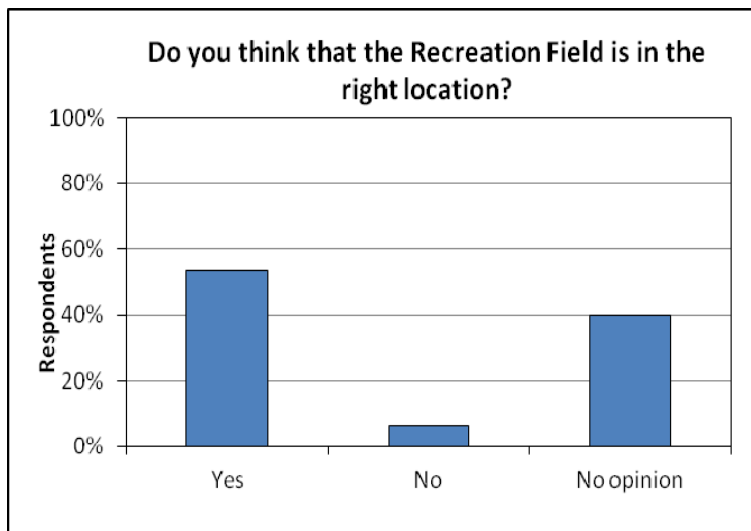

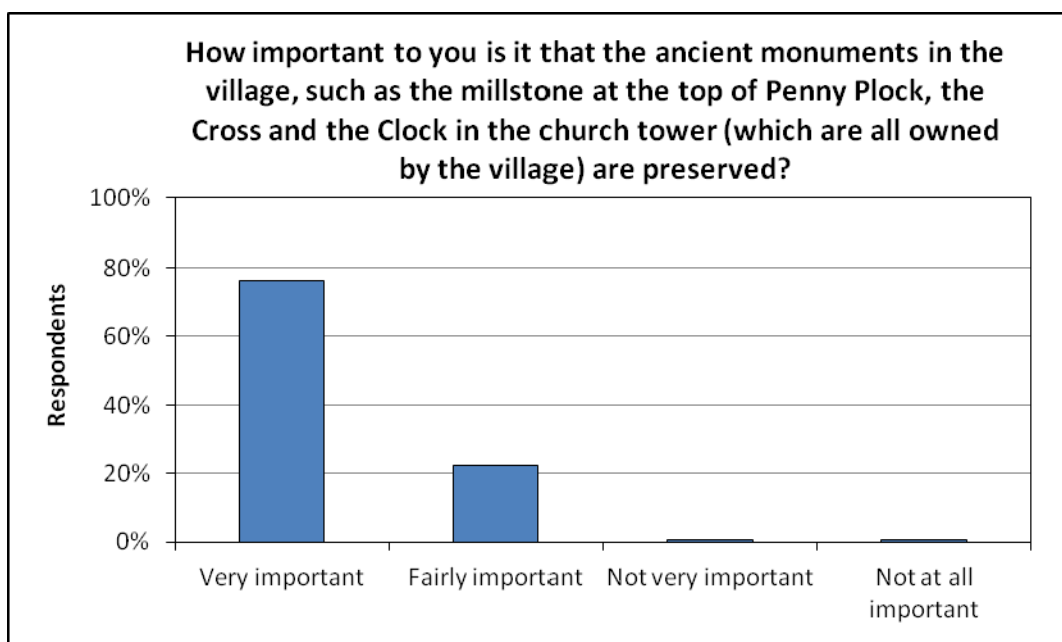

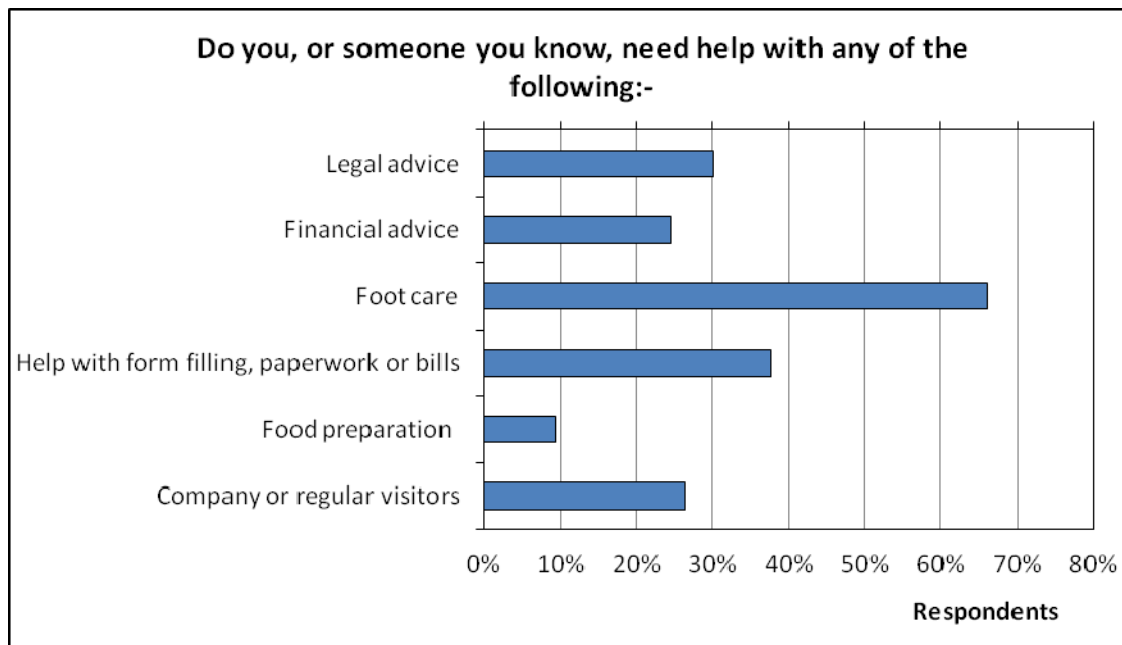

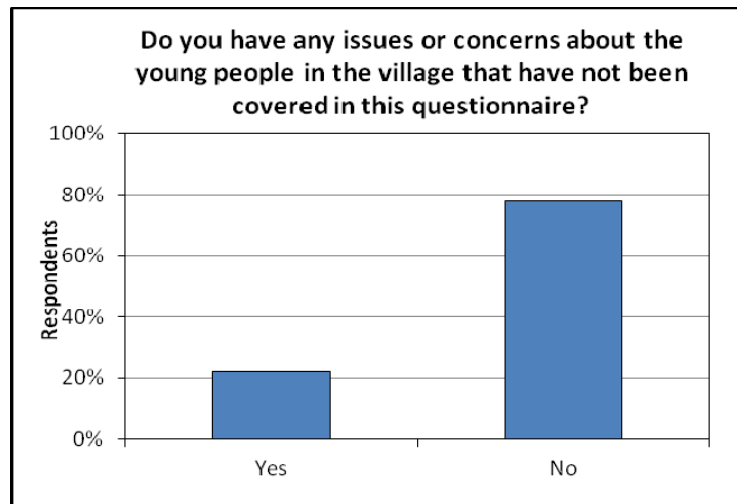

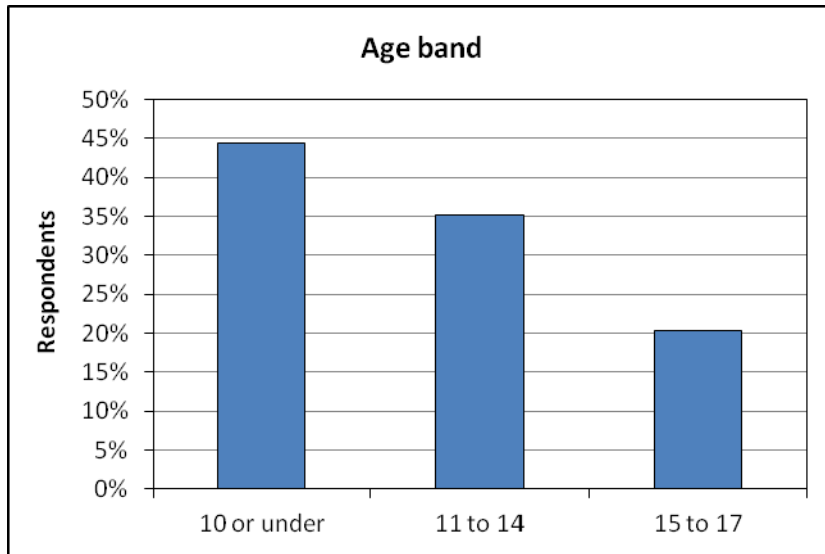
